Although children can attend if suffering from a cold or mild illness they may not be feeling themselves within the playroom environment and may not feel entirely comfortable. We would ask that you please consider this before sending your child to nursery unwell.



#### **ALLERGIES**


We have children and staff members who have severe allergies within the nursery. The following items must not be brought into the nursery environment:
