#### **AUTUMN**

#### ALL CHILDREN SHOULD COME TO NURSERY WITH:

    - WELLIES
  - SEVERAL CHANGES OF CLOTHES
  - SEVERAL SPARE PAIRS OF SOCKS AND PANTS
- SPARE SHOES OR WASHABLE SHOES (I.E CROCS ETC)
  - SUNHAT

If your child comes to nursery without any of the above items you may be called and asked to bring them to the nursery - this ensures your child can safely and comfortably participate in all activities offered during their time at nursery. All items should be labelled with your child's name. If your child has been sent home wearing spare nursery clothes please ensure these are returned to the nursery as soon as possible. This ensures we continue to have spare clothing available for all children within the nursery.



You can also order clothing name tags for your child's belongings from My Name Tag - please visit <a href="https://www.mynametags.com">www.mynametags.com</a> and use the school code 108839 to order personalised name labels for your child's clothing and personal items. It is important that all items of clothing and shoes are labelled with your child's name as this help to minimise the amount of lost property throughout the nursery and helps us to quickly return any lost items to their rightful owner.

#### CHILD SAFETY

To ensure the safety and security of the children during their time at nursery we would like to remind all parents and carers that we operate a NO PHONE policy within the nursery. We would ask all parents and carers to please store their phone in their bag or pocket when you are inside the nursery building. Please do not take phonecalls or have your phone out within the nursery environment. If you are using your phone within the nusery you will be asked to put it away.

If someone different is collecting your child from nursery such as a grandparent / aunt / uncle / family friend etc please make the staff aware as soon as possible. You will be asked to set up a password for your child - you must then inform the person collecting your child what the password is. The password system allows us to safely identify the person collecting your child and adds an extra layer of security. Please bear in mind we see a lot of faces each and every day so please do not take offence if you are asked who are collecting - this is only to ensure the safety of the children at all times.

## DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIMES

We would like to remind all parents & carers that you must bring your children to nursery at their allocated start time and ensure they are collected at their allocated finish time. Staffing rotas are formulated using the numbers of children attending throughout the day. If you bring your child to nursery early or collect them late this can mean the staffing to child ratio is over during this time. Please ensure you stick to your childs allocated nursery times, if you are unsure of what these are please speak to the office. If you bring your child before their allocated start time you will be asked to wait in the foyer until their correct time. If you are running late, which we understand will happen from time to time, please call the nursery ASAP to let us know.
