ILLNESS

If your child is unwell and unable to attend nursery we would ask that you please contact us by phone on 0141-952-9962 at your earliest convenience.

We would also like to remind parents/carers that if your child has experienced any sickness and/or diarrhoea they must be off nursery for 48 hours from the last bout of sickness/diarrhoea. This is vitally important to prevent the spread of illness within the nursery.

We would ask that you please consider if your child will be happy to attend nursery when they are unwell. Although children can attend if suffering from a cold or mild illness they may not be feeling themselves within the playroom environment and may not feel entirely comfortable. We would ask that you please consider this before sending your child to nursery unwell.

SEESAW

The staff have been trialling SeeSaw over the past few weeks and we are hoping to launch this to the 3-5 parents / carers by the middle of March. If you have not yet signed and returned the SeeSaw permission form please see your child's keyworker or pop in to the nursery office.



DATA PROTECTION

Each year staff within Yokerburn complete a refresher training course online about Data Security and Protection. This includes internet safety and other IT safeguards and also important data protection aspects for children and adults such as Confidentiality and Child Protection. We maintain confidentiality for our children and families through all aspects of our practice. From initial application process, settling and enrolment to day to day sharing of information about occurrences/ accidents or incidents and most importantly on Child Protection matters.

We have an 'open- door' policy on information for parents and carers with regard to their own children however at all times child protection issues take precedence for reporting to the appropriate authorities or services. One of our August In-service days includes an annual reminder of National and Local Authority Child Welfare and Safety policy and practice with guidance issued from Glasgow City Council and discussion between management and all staff.

Safety and wellbeing of every child is ensured by the UN Convention on the Rights of the child and we undertake to uphold this right within Yokerburn.

Our parents' room is always available to provide privacy for conversations either between yourself and your child's keyworker or even yourself and other parents. We value parents and carers support to ensure equal security of information and to maintain confidentiality in all aspects of our work.



LUNCH PICK UP TIMES

We would like to remind all parents/carers of 52 week children who are usually collected at 12.30pm that you pick up around 1pm. This helps to avoid you having to wait for your child to finish their lunch. If you could please pass this on to anyone who collects your child at this time.



WORLD BOOK DAY
