# FIRST AID

We have introduced a new process to our First Aid procedure. If a child has a more serious injury at nursery such as a head bump they will be given the above sticker. This sticker is a visual symbol to all staff in the building to observe this child throughout the day for any changes in behaviour. As always, a member of staff will hand over the details of any accidents at collection time and this will continue however this provides an extra measure to ensure all staff are aware throughout the building if a child requires monitoring.



#### **ILLNESS**

If your child is unwell and unable to attend nursery we would ask that you please contact us by phone on 0141-952-9962 at your earliest convenience.

We would also like to remind parents/carers that if your child has experienced any sickness and/or diarrhoea they must be off nursery for 48 hours from the last bout of sickness/diarrhoea. This is vitally important to prevent the spread of illness within the nursery.

We would ask that you please consider if your child will be happy to attend nursery when they are unwell. Although children can attend if suffering from a cold or mild illness they may not be feeling themselves within the playroom environment and may not feel entirely comfortable. We would ask that you please consider this before sending your child to nursery unwell.



## LOST PROPERTY

Thank you for those of you who have collected items from the Lost Property tables. There is now a very large amount of lost property - one table at the main entrance and one table up near the Under 3 rooms. If items are not collected by the end of March they will be donated to charity. We would ask that you please ensure all of your child's clothes, shoes, hats, gloves etc have your child's name on them as this ensures that we can return any lost items to the right owner.
